


Text Sandwich

This assignment is always a fan favorite! For this drawing you will be using your favorite food as inspiration. You are going to think about the ingredients that go into this food and use those to design the text. Notice how the artist has used a bumpy green font to write out “pickles?” Or melting orange font for the “cheese?”

I call this lesson “Text Sandwich” because a sandwich is a really great food item to use. Think about it. What kind of ingredients do you like on your sandwich? Meat? Veggies? Cheese? Sauces? You do not have to create a sandwich! It’s only a suggestion 😊



Part 1: Draw it!

1. Start by choosing your food. Food that is layered on top of each other is the best.
2. Think of the ingredients within your food and their textures. Is there runny sauces? Melty cheese? Chunky chocolate chips?
3. Sketch lightly first, and then add any and all details.
4. Add color or shading!
5. Don't Rush! This should look like it was carefully done and taken at least 45 minutes to 1 hour. Sloppy work will not receive full credit!
