The Town of Niagara Helping Hands are honored to assist you with your opportunity to further your education by offering a \$1,000 college scholarship payable to you.

Students wishing to apply for this scholarship must:

- Be a resident of the Town of Niagara attending any high school OR
 - Attend Niagara Wheatfield Senior High School or Niagara Falls High School
- 2. Be a high school senior eligible for graduation in the current year
- 3. Plan to attend a 2-year or 4-year College or University
- 4. Have an overall academic GPA of 85% or higher
- 5. Participate in extracurricular activities and community service

Candidates who qualify must: (Include each item and submit along with this letter)

- 1. Complete the attached application and submit it with supporting documents to the High School Guidance/Counseling Office at their school no later than Monday, January 6, 2025.
- 2. Provide a 500-word essay (typed and double spaced) on either of the following topics. The essay question you choose **must** be indicated at the top of your essay.
 - a. Explain how volunteer, community service and/or extracurricular activities have shaped who you are today and what they have taught you.
 - b. Describe a time in your life when you demonstrated leadership and overcame obstacles either through school, society, or family life and how this has shaped you as a person.
- 3. Include two letters of recommendation from a teacher, coach, mentor, or others you have worked with closely. No family members, please.
- 4. Include a copy of your transcript.
- 5. Provide proof of acceptance from your college of choice.
- 6. Plan to be available for an in-person interview with the Scholarship Committee.
