But one morning as he was getting ready to play... His mom said,




There's a rotten virus outside *making so many sick*.

To be stuck without friends brought a cloud full of tears.




Sure.

"Let's put this in our window where it's impossible to miss."














Rainbows in windows will help everyone feel less blue.
