are passed to offspring.

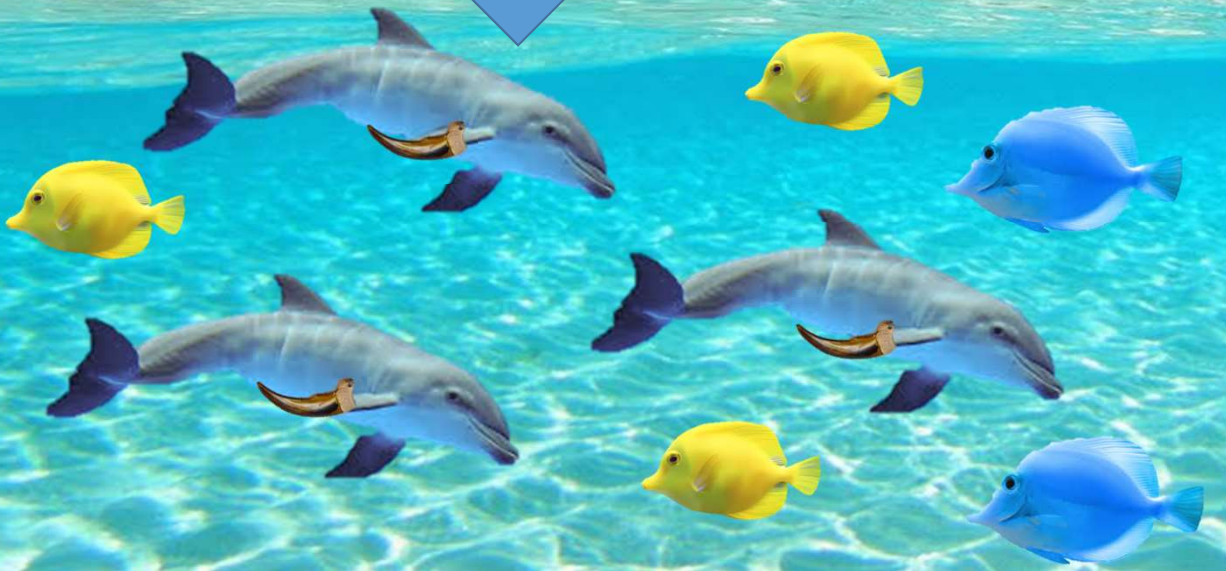


Rule 4: Some variations are helpful. Individuals with helpful variations survive and have a better chance to reproduce.
