The more you fine tune and revise your work, along with creating sketchbook pages focusing on trying different practices, experimenting with composition, subject matter, color schemes, textures, and more, the better. You can even “work backwards” by reimagining or reinventing a work you have already finished in your sketchbook.

Please continue to take notes about your pieces, writing down your thoughts about your creative process and how it relates to your essential questions as you work.

Our AP Exam day will now be **May 26th**. We no longer need to send physical work in, which is a huge relief.

Search for AP Art Digital Submission to find the college board site that you will log into.

Work should be uploaded BEFORE that day, beginning as soon as now if you are ready. I have your passwords and usernames with me, so let me know through the Remind App if you need a refresher.

Take time to not only continue to work and refine your 10 pieces, but to photograph and edit those photos to be the best possible representation of your work. Take time to get good lighting, color balance, and cropping. A great place to photograph work is outside, but in shade rather than direct sun. Make sure your work is “squared up” and cropped right to the edges with no unnecessary backgrounds- except for process photos which can be a little more informal.

Continue to reflect and write about your pieces, which is part of the upload requirement for your exam. As soon as you begin to upload your work, I will be able to see your progress and we can discuss any changes you should make.

The key, as always, is not to wait until the last minute, so let's keep on this!

Keep up the great work and let's finish strong. Let me know what you need and share your progress with me through Remind or Email.

Let me know immediately if you have technology needs. It is possible to upload everything through your phone, but if you have a problem or need assistance, please let me know now.
