First, congrats on finishing and photographing your 10 Sustained Investigation pieces!

Now, Let's upload them to the AP site. <u>https://apstudio.ets.org/apstudioart/</u>

I will txt you your username and password if you forgot them. I will send you the school code and coordinator key. Your AP number should be found under My AP. Txt me through Remind whenever you have a question, except for 2am :)

File size may be an issue as well as the browser you are using. Chrome is recommended as a browser.

If your phone is set to take super high resolution images, which it probably is, you may have to reduce the file size of your images. You will get an error message on the AP site if that is the case. Many students are saying this is a problem. That is just one of the reasons that we have to get this done now rather than nearer to the deadline...these things happen!

Search for "how to reduce photo file size" for IOS or Android, and see which options work for you.

Notes about uploads

- 1) Save OFTEN! The AP site is not as strong as we would like, and crashes do happen.
- 2) Order your work with the best starting and ending the ten slides of the Sustained Investigation. Hide the things you are not as crazy about in the middle.
- 3) I recommend 7 finished works and three process shots, photos of the changes and processes you used to create the finished works. Place those just before the finished works.
- 4) Upload only **10** sustained investigation images, not 15. Only the first 10 will be graded, so fill the last 5 spots with blank photos. Literally, take a photo of your wall, or cover the lens completely and take a photo. There are official "placeholder" images you can find online, but al long as your image is blank you should be fine.
- 5) Upload only **3** quality pieces. Same blank placeholders apply for the other two images, since it was built to accept 5 images. Only the first three will be graded, the others must be blank.

Begin! Feel free to start your commentary, sizes, and anything else you have to fill out...but remember SAVE often. You don't want to lose your writing by accident!
