

2020-2021 School Reopening Programs

Before School Program

This program operates before school starting at 7:15am. NFBGC staff will then take the children to breakfast where the school will then ensure they go to their assigned classrooms. Children will participate in quiet activities to allow each child to get ready for the school day.

First Day of Before School Program will be 9/14/2020.

Locations:

The Before School program will operate in the following schools:

- 79th Street Elementary
- Harry F. Abate Elementary
- Cataract Elementary
- Hyde Park Elementary
- Henry J. Kalfas Elementary
- GJ Mann Elementary
- Maple Ave Elementary
- Niagara Street Elementary

Program Options:

Parents will need to choose one (1) of the following:

- Before School Monday/Tuesday
- Before School Thursday/Friday

Only children who are assigned to be in school for the days can attend the program. You can only register for one of these options. Parents must choose the option that coincides with the schedule provided from the school.

Once registered for the Before School program you will not need to re-register if schools expand the number of in person days. Our program will grow with the school to be able to accommodate kids from both options as the reopening occurs.

Cost:

The Before School program is \$45/month. This cost will remain the same for the entire 2020-2021 school year even as days are added. The cost helps us in the beginning to cover the additional expenses associated with PPE, lower staff ratios, extra supplies to decrease the need for sharing, and cleaning supplies.

After School Program

This program operates after school and ends at 6:00pm. NFBGC staff will work with school personnel to safely transport children from their classrooms to the NFBGC program rooms. Kids will be kept in static groups and remain in the same program room for the duration of the program. All children will receive a snack and will participate in a wide variety of activities such as physical movement, health & life skills programs, homework help, arts, and social recreation activities.

First Day of After School Program will be 9/14/2020.

Locations:

The After School program will operate in the following schools:

- 79th Street Elementary
- Harry F. Abate Elementary
- Cataract Elementary
- Hyde Park Elementary
- Henry J. Kalfas Elementary
- GJ Mann Elementary
- Maple Ave Elementary
- Niagara Street Elementary

Program Options:

Parents will need to choose **one (1)** of the following:

- After School Monday/Tuesday
- After School Thursday/Friday

Only children who are assigned to be in school for the days can attend the program. You can only register for one of these options. Parents must choose the option that coincides with the schedule provided from the school.

Once registered for the After School program you will not need to re-register if schools expand the number of in person days. Our program will grow with the school to be able to accommodate kids from both options as the reopening occurs.

Cost:

The After School program is \$40/month (50% discount of the full price of \$80 offered for all families due to grants/donations received for the program). This cost will remain the same for the entire 2020-2021 school year even as days are added. The cost helps us in the beginning to cover the additional expenses associated with PPE, lower staff ratios, extra supplies to decrease the need for sharing, and cleaning supplies.

Full Day Program at 17th Street

NFBGC will be offering full day programming only at our 17th Street location. We will not be accepting kids after school at this time. This is to help maximize our capacity to assist families during the hybrid school model.

The program will operate Monday through Friday from 7:30am to 6:00pm. Children will remain in static groups and have assigned "homerooms" but will rotate throughout the day to the gym and outside play areas. All children will receive breakfast, lunch and a snack and will participate in a wide variety of activities such as physical movement, health & life skills programs, homework help, arts, and social recreation activities. NFBGC Staff will work with the District and parents to facilitate remote learning homework.

First Day of Full Day Program will be 9/14/2020.

Program Options:

Parents will need to choose one (1) of the following:

- Full Day Monday/Tuesday
- Full Day Thursday/Friday

We have created two different program sign ups to maximize our capacity for each of the hybrid groups. You can only register for one of these options. Parents must choose the option that coincides with the schedule provided from the school.

We will also be offering:

Full Day Wednesday

We needed to make this a separate program sign up because our capacity is the same as the other days and we cannot accommodate everyone that signs up for M/T or TH/F. We understand that Wednesdays will be a needed day for full day care and are working on additional locations.

As school reopens to add more in person class time, 17th street will transition from a full day program back to our afterschool program. We are unsure as to the details of this transition because we will need to wait to be able to react to the Districts reopening process.

Cost:

The full day program for Monday Tuesday or Thursday Friday is \$30/month, Wednesday program will be an additional \$10/month (75% discount of the full price of \$160 offered for all families due to grants/donations received for the program). The cost helps us in the beginning to cover the additional expenses associated with PPE, lower staff ratios, extra supplies to decrease the need for sharing, and cleaning supplies. The cost of the 17th street after school program will be determined later. It is dependent on other potential funding as well as when the transition occurs.

How to Register

Registration for all school year program offerings will be completed through the NFBGC Parent Portal.

It is easier for us to help in the beginning then to try to fix something later.

Once you call us and/or are logged in to the portal you will need to do the following:

- 1. Review your child(ren) information, contact information, etc. Update anything that needs updating.
- 2. Click enroll
- 3. Nothing can be added to your "cart" until the once a year \$10 membership/application fee is paid. This is due ever year starting 7/1/20. If your child attended our 2020 summer camp it was already paid and you can move to step 4.
- 4. Once the membership is paid you can then proceed to enroll your child(ren) into additional programs.
- 5. You put the program you wish to enroll your child in the cart. Once all programs are added you check out.
- 6. You will be given the option of selecting one of the 3 payment options:
 - a. Auto pay the system will automatically charge the card you use for the first month payment each month thereafter. This can be stopped at any time in the system or by calling our offices
 - b. Manual pay you need to log in and pay every month. You can also pay via check by mail, credit card by phone etc.
 - c. Pay in full pay the full balance for the entire school year now
- 7. In order to be fully registered and claim a spot in the program you must pay the first month (September) at time of enrollment.
- 8. If the capacity for a program are reached you may receive a notice that your child was placed on a wait list. NFBGC will then contact you when a spot opens for the program.
