- May be administered anytime during the year
- May be used as 1-point toward Seal of Civic Readiness

Must be added to Gradebook in Q4

- Create assignment in Q4, named Capstone Project, category type Project
- Choose the setting for traditional grade calculation, Q4 marking period
- Enter as 20% of Q4 grade, make sure all other assignments, quizzes, tests, etc. add up to 80%

Appendix D SPANISH

Results of the STAMP 4S will appear on the Grade 8 Report Card. Since the intent of this assessment is for screening and not grading purposes, the following protocol should be followed:

- Enter the score received in the P6 field
- If a score is at or above 2.5, you should round up
- **EXCEPTION**: Since a score of 2 indicates that the student is at expected levels for Spanish 1, a score of less than 2 does not qualify. Therefore, a score of 1.5 should be rounded down.
- Enter a comment:
 - Student is at standard (Use for level 2)
 - Student is above standard (Use for any score greater than 2)
 - Student is below standard (Use for any score below 2)
