

#### A MESSAGE FROM THE DRODUCER

Good evening and welcome to BEAUTIFUL: The Carole King Musical!

This has been one heck of a ride and one of the longest productions we have ever worked on. Traditionally we start a production and put it up within three months. We began this amazing adventure in May of 2023. As music director, I learned the entire score. Christina had all the songs and piano parts memorized. We were planning sets and projections. We truly were off and running full-steam ahead until the bottom fell out. We received an official notice that our performance rights were cancelled. We were crushed. As producer, I was shocked, angry, frustrated, sad and disappointed to say the least. We were all so excited to do this show, and then it came crashing down. So being the stubborn theatre that people we are, we fought a good fight and were persistent so we could still be able to do this show. Finally, in late November of 2023, were given the green light after several months of back-and-forth e-mails and phone calls pleading our case with the representatives from the licensing company in New York. Fast forward to Summer of 2024, after having completed three other productions during last school year, we held auditions for the show in July and vocal rehearsals began in early August. We were once again running full-steam ahead bringing -us to today.

Despite the initial frustrations, this has been such a rewarding experience for everyone involved. This is probably the biggest production that we have done to date. On the surface, it seems like it is a rather simple show, but there are so many pieces to this wonderful musical puzzle. Set pieces are constantly moving from scene to scene (act one having 22 scenes alone!), a live, professional 9-piece band on stage and a rare opportunity to have an actress portraying Carole King that plays all of her songs on the piano LIVE! Most of the actresses who have played Carole, including those on Broadway and the National Tours have all faked it...NOT US! Christina Custode is doing it all live! The cast of singers, actors, dancers and musician are going to blow you away. They are all so talented and such a pleasure to work with. And the best part...they are doing it all to help support students and the Theatre Department at Niagara Falls High School.

The community and alumni productions that we have done once a year are produced not only to give former students and members of the community a chance to perform once again on our stage, but to create revenue that directly benefits the theatre program at NFHS. Theatrical productions are very costly events and without the support of you, our patrons, coming to see all of our shows and buying tickets, concessions, 50/50 raffle tickets and other donations, we would not be able to continue produce the professional quality productions that we have been fortunate enough to bring to our stage over the years. That being said, the production staff and the students thank you from the bottom of our hearts for supporting the performing arts in our school.

Usually at this point, I tell you to sit back, relax and enjoy the show. But not tonight. Tonight I tell you get ready to "feel the earth move" with this rockin' cast and band. And there's a little surprise at the end. So if you feel like standing up and dancing...go right ahead! So with that, get ready to have your toes tapping all night lone and enjoy this very entertaining production of BEAUTIFUL: The Carole King Musical featuring the soundtrack of a whole generation and more!
