

A MESSAGE FROM THE DRODUCER

Hello all!

Welcome to our production of *Godspell*! It's hard to believe that this production marks the 22nd show that the Niagara Proscenium Players have presented to you since 2018! Last year, our production staff met to discuss possible shows for this year. We knew that we wanted a show that was fun, colorful and could accommodate the many talents of a large cast. I am so thrilled that we've achieved that with this show.

The official description of the show is that *Godspell* is a musical in two acts with music and lyrics by Stephen Schwartz and a book by John-Michael Tebelak. The show is structured as a series of parables, primarily based on the Gospel of Matthew, interspersed with music mostly set to lyrics from traditional hymns, with the passion of Christ appearing briefly near the end. Although it is indeed that, it's a hysterical show that allows the performers to stretch their talents as improve actors. The show is not meant to preach, change or enhance anyone's personal beliefs. I truly view the show as something that embraces love, family, friendship, support and kindness.

As a director, I am so thrilled that the cast was able to challenge themselves and find the joy in creating fun-loving characters. What is so special about *Godspell* is that every production ever done is unique with original and specific themes. Our theme addresses the military and what it must be like to be far from home missing the love, family, friendship, support and kindness that I mentioned above. To take their minds off of their current situation these soldiers escape into a "fantasy" land where stories (parables) that made them feel safe and joyful as children are the very stories that resonates with them as adults.

Godspell began as a project by drama students at Carnegie Mellon University and then moved to the off-off-Broadway theater La MaMa Experimental Theatre Club in the East Village of Manhattan. The show was rescored for an off-Broadway production, which opened on May 17, 1971, and became a long-running success. Many productions have followed worldwide, including a 2011 Broadway revival.

The Niagara Proscenium Players are proud to be a part of a long, long list of theatre companies that have brought this show to audiences world-wide! We invite you to sit back and enjoy this wonderful and entertaining show!

Audrianna Yates is a seasoned performer, director, choreographer, and educator with over 25 years of experience in the performing arts. After graduating in 2007, Audrianna pursued her passion for theater, studying at SUNY Niagara and later at Niagara University. She gained invaluable experience working with the entertainment department at SeaWorld Busch Gardens, where she performed, costumed, and contributed to various technical aspects for 9 seasons. Audrianna returned to Buffalo to follow her calling in education, driven by a deep commitment to inspiring young minds in the arts. For the past 16 years, she has taught at Jaclyn Carol's Dance Academy, working with students of all ages and skill levels across various dance styles, including competitive dance. Under her guidance, students have earned top awards at regional and national competitions.

Audrianna's work has earned her numerous Director's Choice and Choreography awards, a testament to her dedication. Audrianna is also a sought-after dance competition judge, traveling across the country to critique and assess various styles of dance. Her diverse experience, both on and off the stage, has solidified her reputation as an influential and respected figure in the arts community.

In addition to her role as an educator, Audrianna has remained an active presence in the local arts community.  - Nominee exhibited a notable dedication to the department.
 - Nominee does not need to be a graduate of the NFCSD but was employed as a staff member in a school in the NFCSD or was employed as a "sub-contracted" staff member for a/some production(s).
- 3. Nominee was an alumnus of the theatre department and is now/was actively working in theatre in a professional/semi-professional capacity
- 4. Award may be granted posthumously.


