Smokey Joe's Café. Dennis is an accomplished choreographer, having staged productions of Sophisticated Ladies, Ragtime, The Wiz, Cabaret, West Side Story, The King and I, Smokey Joe's Café and Jesus Christ Superstar. In 2005, Dennis founded a theatrical production company, Dendewil Productions. Dennis also humbly adds the title of author to his credits having written and self-published three books, My Void My Voice (Poetry 2012), Eros Dennis (Poetry 2013), Morning Coffee Thoughts (Positive Affirmations 2016). Dennis wrote, produced and directed his first web series. The Therapist, which had its premiere in October 2021 on YouTube. During the summer of 2022, Dennis recorded an audio version of his poetry from his publication, My Void My Voice. Most recently, Dennis appeared as the Apparition in an original Regional-World Premiere of The Magnolia Ballet at the Alleyway Theatre in Buffalo, NY. Dennis currently resides in Niagara Falls and teaches theatre at Niagara Falls High School.

A MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

"Another Opening, Another Show!"

Welcome to Hello Dolly!

This musical is an all-time American favorite and has remained popular for decades. Michael Stewart created the book for the musical *Hello*, *Dolly!*, while Jerry Herman wrote the music and lyrics. The story is a comedy, and it was first produced in 1964 for the Broadway stage. It was based on the play *The Matchmaker* by the famous playwright Thornton Wilder.

The first run of the show on Broadway lasted for almost 3000 performances. In 1964 it won the Tony Award for Best Musical, along with nine other Tonys. Famously, Carol Channing was the first actress to play the main character of Mrs. Dolly Gallagher Levi in the first Broadway run. Other actresses and actors that have been in the musical are Barbara Streisand, Bette Midler, Pearl Bailey, Bernadette Peters, Walter Matthau, and Michael Crawford.

What drew me to the show was the nostalgia of the golden age of musical theatre when the music was indeed written with the human voice in mind. *Hello*, *Dolly!* has some of the most beautiful and timeless songs and a cast of charming characters who make you fall in love with them.

As always with our shows, we strive to produce fun and exciting projects for our students to showcase their talents. It is also important to us that we create educational moments for the students as well. *Hello, Dolly!* is a perfect show to teach them the beauty of "the old time" musicals. As a director, I live for those moments when I see the light and joy in the kid's eyes when they are introduced to new material that is actually vintage.
