Tom's has over 100 theatre credits to his name including: Anything Goes!, The Pajama Game, Guys and Dolls, A Chorus Line, Forum, The Music Man, Grease, Hello, Dolly!, Fiddler on the Roof, Godspell, Little Shop of Horrors, Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat, Company, Pippin, Man of La Mancha, Evita, Children of Eden, Steel Magnolias, Annie, Bye Bye Birdie, Barry Manilow's Copacabana, Jekyll and Hyde, Les Miserábles, Chicago, The Rocky Horror Show, Smokey Joe's Café, Ragtime, Willy Wonka, The Addams Family, Hairspray, Mamma Mia!, On Golden Pond, Crimes of the Heart, The Diary of Anne Frank, West Side Story and Beautiful – The Carole King Musical. Other music credits include: Handel's Messiah, Berlioz' Messe Sollennelle, Mahler's Symphony 8 – Symphony for a Thousand, Tchaikovsky's 1812 Overture, and other selected works all performed with the Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra and the Holy Trinity Lutheran Concert Choir. Tom was as the Music Director, Arranger and Studio Musician for two CD recordings, My Father's Hymns and Broadway and Beyond, by local artist Lee Stevens. In 2008, Tom performed in concert with Grammy Award Winning Singer/Songwriter Kenny Loggins at Artpark. Tom has worked with the theatre departments of Lewiston-Porter, Starpoint, City Honors School and Niagara Falls High School and has been on the production staff for several productions at NCCC. Tom served as the Drama Club Advisor/Director for Niagara Catholic from 2000 to 2006. For the Fall 2005 semester, Tom was an Adjunct/Musical Director for the theatre department of NCCC. Tom proudly is co-founder of the Niagara Falls City School District Theatre Hall of Fame. In 2021, Tom was the Executive Producer of the web series Dennis Wilson's The Therapist, for which he composed and recorded all the underscoring and theme song, Journey. In Fall of 2022, Tom composed and recorded the instrumental music for the Niagara Proscenium Alumni Players production of On Golden Pond. In January of 2023, Tom performed Off-Broadway at 54 Below in New York City as a pianist for a special engagement of the Stage Door Medium with Jimmy Moses, accompanying Broadway stars Jenny DiNoia and Hayley Podschun. Tom would like to thank his husband Jacob for being so patient and supportive during theatre season and always.

The next few years Dennis engaged in a professional acting career. Dennis has performed in the National and Canadian Touring Companies of Five Guys Named Moe (Little). Regional credits include: Once On This Island (Papa Ge), Toys in the Attic (Gus), Ain't Misbehavin (Andre), The Zoo Story (Peter), A Chorus Line (Mike & Bobby), Cabaret (Kit Kat Girl), West Side Story (Luis), Dutchman (Clay), Jesus Christ Superstar (Judas), Hair (Tribe Member), Smokey Joe's Café. Dennis is an accomplished choreographer, having staged productions of Sophisticated Ladies, Ragtime, The Wiz, Cabaret, West Side Story, The King and I, Smokey Joe's Café and Jesus Christ Superstar. In 2005, Dennis founded a theatrical production company, Dendewil Productions. Dennis also humbly adds the title of author to his credits having written and self-published three books, My Void My Voice (Poetry 2012), Eros Dennis (Poetry 2013), Morning Coffee Thoughts (Positive Affirmations 2016). Dennis wrote, produced and directed his first web series. The Therapist, which had its premiere in October 2021 on YouTube. During the summer of 2022, Dennis recorded an audio version of his poetry from his publication, My Void My Voice. In 2023, Dennis appeared as the Apparition in an original Regional-World Premiere of The Magnolia Ballet at the Alleyway Theatre in Buffalo, NY. Last season, Dennis directed a production of The Taming at Niagara University and directed a staged reading workshop of a new musical, Cataract House. Dennis currently resides in Niagara Falls and teaches theatre at Niagara Falls High School.

Other revivals included a flip-gender 1985 Broadway production starring Rita Moreno as Olive Madison and Sally Struthers as Florence Unger.
